	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ It is a family business listed in the Tokyo and Osaka stock exchanges; ➤ The company is named after its founder Kiusuke Shimizu; ➤ In 2008, announced the corporate slogan of “Today’s Work, Tomorrow’s Heritage” Shimizu unveils Green Float, a concept for a city that floats on the ocean. GREEN FLOAT the first series of future-city concepts known as Shimizu Dream; ➤ Mode Gakuen Cocoon Tower received first international Emporis Skyscraper Award in Japan for construction of a high-rise building; ➤ In 2021, accepted “SHIMZ beyond Zero 2050” Shimizu Group’s New Environmental Vision.
Projects in MENA region	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Based in Dubai, works for various projects in Africa and Middle East; ➤ So far has constructed Roads, Bridges, Schools, and Hospitals, totalling 91 projects in 13 African countries; ➤ In the Middle East, was active in UAE, Iraq, Kuwait, Bahrain and Syria in 1980s; ➤ Resumed its operations by participating in the construction projects in UAE (2006) and Turkey (2013).
